

## St. Mary's Church



One of the most significant buildings in Mühlhausen is St. Mary's Church. An impressive architectural and historic monument, it represents the proud history of this former imperial town.

No matter which direction you approach Mühlhausen from, the 86-m-high tower of St. Mary's Church soars above the Medieval town. The church is the second largest in Thuringia, with the highest church tower. Today it serves primarily as a museum, offering space for art and culture. German Peasants' Revolt leader Thomas Müntzer once preached from the pulpit of St. Mary's Church. Johann Sebastian Bach's Ratswahlkantate was heard here for the first time. History is not only documented in this impressive religious building, it is also still tangible to this day.
