10 parks & theme gardens turn the spa town of Bad Langensalza into a green oasis at the edge of the Hainich Park. And friends of medieval feasts will also get their money's worth here.

Once a year, knights, maids, jugglers and traders take over power in Bad Langensalza. The medieval city festival attracts thousands of magnificently garbed guests. But at any other time, it is also worth a visit: in the children's adventure world "[Rumpelburg](#)" which is an indoor playground, the young children can romp around and perform handicraft work, adults may enjoy a visit to the thermal bath, and a walk through the Japanese Garden or the rose garden delights visitors of any age – just like an excursion to the nearby [canopy walkway](#).
